Think it's a Calculator? Think again... How to look for Ghost Apps

What Is a "Ghost App" or "Vault App"?

These apps are designed to look one way, but they do something entirely different—allowing for secret storage of photos, videos, and more.

Many "ghost apps" will ask for a PIN code if you tap on them.

Another way to detect "ghost apps" is to check the phone settings. If a seemingly innocuous app is using lots of data, then ask questions.

Parents and teachers alike should talk to children and teens about the risks involved in sharing any personal information online, but *especially* photos/videos.

An icon may look like a normal calculator or a utilities icon, but clicking it will then require a PIN code for access.
